

SPRING VALLEY STUDENT DRESS CODE/NUSIANCE ITEMS 2018-19

- 1.** All students must wear shoes with soles. Slippers are not allowed and certain classes do not allow flip flops (this is at the discretion of the teacher).
- 2.** Shirts and blouses must be appropriately buttoned in accordance with its design. Tops must extend **BELOW** the belt line. No skin may show between the bottom of the shirt and the top of the pant/skirt/shorts. Wearing a second top/sweater over an inappropriate blouse/shirt does not make it legal.
- 3.** Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be fingertip length. Shorts must have a hem. No frayed shorts.
- 4.** Transparent, see through tops, bare midriff, strapless, tank tops, low cut clothing, tops with cut outs or slits, spaghetti strap tops or clothing that provide minimum coverage are not allowed. Shoulders must be covered. If wearing a sleeveless jersey, a t-shirt must be worn underneath it. Wearing a second top/sweater/jacket/vest that allows the inappropriate tops to be visible is dress code. Clothing designed as an undergarment is unacceptable and should not be worn to school.
- 5.** Sagging is unacceptable at any time. Pants are to be worn above the posterior. If pants are ripped and/or torn above the knee then skin must be covered with leggings or shorts.
- 6.** Headgear is not allowed on campus except for designated school approved uniforms. Hats must be removed and placed in backpacks, not hanging from belt loops. Bandannas, stocking caps, rags, hair scarves or beanies are not allowed on campus and may be confiscated at any time. Hoods are not to be on heads when on campus.
- 7.** Clothing/socks/shoes/jewelry and backpacks that have graphics, slogans, or advertising that are obscene or have controversial references in nature are not allowed. Chains used as jewelry or attached to a wallet are not allowed. Spiked, studded, or safety pin clothing, shoes or accessories are not allowed.
- 8.** Sleepwear is not allowed on campus.
- 9.** Sunglasses are not allowed inside the building.
- 10.** Cold weather gear should be removed once student is on campus in the building. Full length dusters/trench coats are prohibited.

IF YOU ARE FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THE DRESS CODE:

Students will be sent to the Dean's Office to change out of inappropriate attire when observed by a teacher, CSM, office staff, or administration. Students will be asked to change into school approved attire before attending any class. Dress code violations will be recorded in Infinite Campus and progressive discipline will occur if this behavior becomes habitual.

ITEMS PROHIBITED AT SCHOOL

Personal phone use must follow the SVHS “stoplight” policy.

No student radios, iPods, TV's, tape recorders, PSPs, toys, fidget spinners, or other nuisance items are permitted on campus. Since these items should not be on campus, the school will not be held responsible if they are lost or stolen. Parents may pick up the items after school hours between 2 p.m. and 3 p.m.

Ear-buds and headphones are prohibited (except before school, during the nutrition break and during lunch) and should be stored in a NON-VISIBLE location by students. Ear-bud and headphones will be confiscated by school staff and placed in an envelope marked with name/student number and sent immediately to the Dean’s office. Parents may pick up these items between 2 p.m. and 3 p.m.

Skateboards/scooters must be kept in lockers or locked up in the skateboard holders in the quad or by the dean’s office. Students should have their own locks to secure them. Students will not be allowed to walk around with them and teachers are not to be asked to hold on to them for the students. At no time will students be allowed to ride them on the school campus.

Gum is not allowed on campus.

Bicycles and mopeds should be locked up in the bike rack cage. They should not be locked up to light poles or fences outside of the bike rack cage. Students must have their own locks for this.
